DE-ICING ROADS

CVSD crews plowed/ salted streets on 2/16, 2/17, 2/18, 2/20, 2/22, 2/28 & 3/1/15 to treat roads in all five sectors.

Cherokee Village plowing will be performed between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, primarily during daylight hours to maximize efficiency and safety.

The CVSD 2015 Annual Budget has been approved by City Council.

CVSD received **222** work order requests and **completed 179 work orders** (80% completed within the month).

FEMA UPDATE

Final reimbursement amounts \$50,427.10. No monies received to date.

FEMA has closed two of the three projects submitted.

TRIMMING AND ROWS

CVSD and our grant workers continue to perform pre-storm tree limbing and trimming on major roads and streets, as weather permits.

MECHANIC'S CORNER

The CVSD Mechanics have completed 15 work orders and had supported other departments by completing three jobs.

CVP&Z sold the salvage 1995 Chevrolet to CVSD for \$352.52. CVSD is rehabbing the truck for use by the mechanics for service calls within the city and parts acquisition.

MUTCD SIGN UPDATES

Federal mandatory sign regulatory survey continues is complete as of February 27, 2015.

A grant crew is repairing multiple road signs and repairing posts.

Street name sign repairs/ replacements are being scheduled and performed.



GRANTS UPDATE

State Aid City Street Program denied funds in 2015. Funding has been requested for projects in 2016.

CVSD is still benefiting from NADC and Experience Works grant workers at no expense to the city of Cherokee Village.

60 ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

CVSD crews are helping to prepare Cherokee Village for the 60th Anniversary by limbing trees, trimming brush, and mowing as the weather permits.
