

ONAGA ROAD UPDATE: STATUS COMPLETE



The CVSD 2015 Annual Budget has been submitted to City Council for approval.

CVSD received **186** work order requests and **completed 105 work orders.**

FEMA UPDATE

CVSD has completed the disaster closeout request for FEMA projects DR-1861, project DR-1975, and project DR-4174. Final reimbursement amounts \$50,427.10. No closeout monies received to date.

TRIMMING AND ROWS

CVSD and our grant workers continue to perform pre-storm tree limbing and trimming on major roads and streets, as weather permits.

DE-ICING ROADS

CVSD crews were called out during the ice event on 1/11/15 to treat roads in all five sectors. Cherokee Village plowing will be performed between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, primarily during daylight hours to maximize efficiency and safety.

MECHANIC'S CORNER

The CVSD Mechanics have completed the project to rebuild a CVPD police car by taking the two damaged cars and making one. It was delivered back to Chief Crook on 1/16/15.

The CVSD Mechanics have completed 10 work orders and had supported other departments by 3.



MUTCD SIGN UPDATES

Federal mandatory sign regulatory survey continues. Sectors 1, 2, 3, and 4 are complete. The survey for Sector 5 is 70% complete. A grant crew is repairing multiple road signs and repairing posts. Street name sign repairs will be performed when the survey is completed.

GRANTS UPDATE

CVSD submitted a grant request for the 2015 Arkansas State Aid City Street Program. We were denied funds in 2015. Funding has been requested for projects in 2016.

CAPITAL EXPENDITURES

CVSD requested the City Council to make a capital purchase for a new backhoe using FEMA funds. The council approved this at their 1/15/15 meeting. The City Council also approved the sale or trade in of a 1999 Case Backhoe as surplus equipment.
