

SNOW REMOVAL

CVSD crews plowed/ salted streets on March 1, 2015 in all five sectors.

Cherokee Village plowing is performed between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, primarily during daylight hours to maximize efficiency and safety.



CVSD received **222** work order requests and **completed 179 work orders** (80% complete within the month).

FEMA UPDATE

Final reimbursement amounts \$50,427.10. No monies received to date.

FEMA has closed two of the three projects submitted.

TRIMMING AND ROWS

CVSD and our grant workers continue to perform pre-storm tree limbing and trimming on major roads and streets, as weather permits.



MECHANIC'S CORNER

The CVSD Mechanics have completed 23 work orders and had supported other departments by completing six jobs.

CVP&Z sold the salvage 1995 Chevrolet to CVSD for \$352.52. CVSD is rehabbing the truck for use by the mechanics for service calls within the city and parts acquisition.

MUTCD SIGN UPDATES

The federal mandatory sign regulatory survey is complete. Cherokee Village has 296 +/- miles of roads. There are a total of 1423 signs, 255 are traffic control signs, and 1168 are street signs. Street name sign repairs/ replacements are being scheduled and performed by a grant crew, primary traffic areas are being repaired and replaced first.

GRANTS UPDATE

CVSD is still benefiting from NADC and Experience Works grant workers at no expense to the city of Cherokee Village. There was a week suspension of services for NADC this month, due to clerical problems at the federal grant level.
