CVSD has TWO WIOA Youth Grant workers. Additionally, CVSD acquired a WIOA Grant worker for P & Z, welcome to Justin Lopez. Experience Works grant worker, is still working 18 hours per week. We also have one part time (29 hours per week) OJT Grant worker, Jason White.



ROW & DITCHING

CVSD is working to maintain our ROW (right of ways) and clearing to maintain our ditches in various areas of the city.

FEMA

CVSD is still waiting on \$32,372 in FEMA payments. Representative Scott Baltz spoke to them in December, and they stated that our request was being processed and should have received it in January.

LIMBING & TRIMMING

CVSD is still on various streets through out the city trimming limbs and clearing out overgrown vegetation. Weather permitting.

MECHANIC'S CORNER

The CVSD Mechanics have completed 31 repair orders, of these jobs; three repairs were for CVPD, as well repairing the mini dump purchased in December and modifying the tank sprayer to be pulled behind a vehicle to aid in weed and grass prevention on the roadways.

CVSD 2016 FOCUS

CVSD work for 2016 will be focused on infrastructure preservation. (clearing right of ways, ditching, tree trimming etc.)

CVSD received **82** work order requests and **completed 59** work orders.
