## MECHANIC'S CORNER

The CVSD Mechanics have completed 20 special request repair orders in addition to the general repairs for the department. General repairs included tractors, mowers (sickle bars and brush hogs), air system on road grader, and steering cylinder on sweeper as well as tire replacements on three of the tractors utilized for mowing.
