

MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

APRIL 20, 1998

Mayor Marjorie Rogers brought the meeting to order at 12:00 PM. All aldermen were present: Allen Maxedon, Fritz Lorentzen, Jay Torbit, Hobie Weisman and Buddy White. Also present were Recorder-Treasurer, Susan Maynard and Attorney Mark Johnson.

Guests included Fulton County Judge Everett (running for re-election) and Fulton County Treasurer Boyd Hickinbotham who is running for State Representative in District 66.

The minutes of the March 16 meeting were read. Mr. Lorentzen motioned the minutes be accepted as read. Mr. Maxedon seconded. Motion passed. March 31, 1998 financial report was passed out, and filed for audit.

Mr. White motioned to open a savings account so we are able to keep the Street Funds separate. Mr. Weisman seconded. Roll call vote was taken. Motion passed unanimously.

Correspondence from Arkansas Municipal League, City of West Helena, Southern Building Code Congress International, U.S. Dept. of Commerce, and White River Planning & Development District was made available for viewing.

It was decided that Mr. White and Mr. Lorentzen will head up a Road Committee to find four additional members and come up with an outline regarding its responsibilities by the next meeting.

None of our members had been able to attend the March Quorum Court meeting. Mr. Newell Darnier of the audience reported going, but nothing discussed pertained to Cherokee Village West.

Mr. Johnson reported on the hearing of Campbell vs. Cherokee Village West. Mr. Torbit motioned we seek redress for attorney's fees of approximately \$1,800. Mr. White seconded. Mr. Johnson stated he could write a letter and also address the Judge in the presence of Mr. Kisse. Roll call vote was taken. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. White stated he had sold controlling interest of his trash business.

Mayor Rogers reported that two members of CCC had passed away and one was very ill. She had been asked if the Annexation Election could be dedicated to them. It was decided to table discussion until after the election, then possibly plant a tree, etc. at a dedication service.

Mr. Johnson suggested we might want to establish a By-Laws Committee. Also check with other City or Towns to review what they have in place for By-Laws.


June 4-6 is an education seminar for aldermen and potential aldermen.
