

## MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

MARCH 16, 1998

Mayor Marjorie Rogers brought the meeting to order at 1:00 PM. Four aldermen were present: Allen Maxedon, Fritz Lorentzen, Jay Torbit and Hobie Weisman, with Buddy White being absent. Also present were Recorder-Treasurer, Susan Maynard and Attorney Mark Johnson.

The minutes of the February 16 meeting were read. Mr. Weisman motioned the minutes be accepted as corrected. Mr. Maxedon seconded. Motion passed. February 28, 1998 financial report was read, corrected and filed for audit.

Mayor Rogers reported the postcard printing for Sharp County was an additional \$97.00 for a total of \$197.00 as there was printing on both sides of the card.

Correspondence from Arkansas Municipal League, and the Lt. Governor's office, a booklet entitled "American's with Disabilities Act Compliance Guide", and a video, "Avoiding Lawsuits" were made available for viewing.

The turnback funds payment was discussed. They are on line to be paid in April.

Mr. Weisman had gone to the latest Quorum Court meeting, during which the budget was still being discussed. Nothing connected with Cherokee Village West.

Discussion regarding Campbell vs. Cherokee Village West. Mr. Campbell filed for an injunction against the incorporation election in Fulton County Chancery Court March 13. Hearing will probably be set for March 31. Mr. Campbell has to show this election will do him irreparable harm. Was there an agreement made, prior to our becoming incorporated, not to hold an incorporation election? Mr. Johnson will be filing a response within 20 days after his being served with these papers. Mr. Oral Henderson, Petitioner, asked if the Judge of the Chancery Court will actually hear this complaint? Mr. Johnson feels he will. They (Campbell) have the burden of proof. Mr. Henderson questioned if the complaint could be construed as frivolous. Probably not, per Mr. Johnson. Mayor Rogers and Mr. Henderson stated not knowing Mr. Campbell or

Mr. Kisse. Everyone present was in agreement that Mr. Johnson should go ahead with what he feels should be filed.

Next meeting will be April 20, 1998 at 12:00 noon so we can attend the POA meeting.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Mr. Maxedon. Mr. Weisman seconded. Meeting adjourned at 1:00 pm.
