

CITY OF CHEROKEE VILLAGE, ARKANSAS
City Council Minutes
March 15, 1999

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 1:00 PM Monday, March 15, 1999 by Mayor Marjorie Rogers. The meeting was held in the Recreation Room at Omaha Center.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve the February 8 and 15, 1999 minutes as presented was made by Joe Waggoner and seconded by Louisa Relyea. With a voice vote of eight ayes, motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Financial reports were reviewed and will be filed for audit.

CORRESPONDENCE:

An invitation to a Regional Officials Meeting presented by the White River Planning & Development District, Inc. was read and discussed.

REPORTS:

Airport: Louisa Relyea introduced Henry Bauman of the Sharp County Regional Airport.

Animal Control: An ordinance will be presented for passing and budget will be revised at the working session.

Budget: Revisions to be discussed at the working session.

Emergency Services: Mrs. Relyea is working with several ideas.

Environmental: Vivian Herbert introduced Michelle Gillian and Robert Hunter with the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality who will present a program later. Joe Waggoner announced there will be a clean-up in the Santa Fe addition Friday and Saturday, March 19 & 20. More man-power is needed and Evelyn Albertson will distribute flyers.

Planning and Zoning: No report.

Police and Security: Dan Dennis reported the addition of Floyd Hannon as a new member of the Committee. Mr. Dennis attended the March Fulton County Quorum Court meeting and discussed contracting with the Sheriff's Department. IZARD County has a similar situation and the Fulton County Sheriff is to check with them to see how it is handled there. Mr. Dennis also discussed the over-abundance of speeding tickets being given out by S.I.D. Security.

Roads: Jay Torbit reported that he has talked with two S.I.D. officials and Ray Maynard has talked with the Sharp County Judge as to contracting with each department. We need to wait for better weather before starting to work.

Mayor Rogers has been working with North Arkansas Electric Coop to get a security light at the intersection of Hwys 175 & 289.

OLD BUSINESS:

Clerk/Treasurer Maynard read **An Ordinance Providing for Licensing and Animal Control Within the City of Cherokee Village, Arkansas Establishing Penalties for the Violation Thereof, Declaring an Emergency and for Other Purposes.** Mayor Rogers declared the Ordinance open for discussion. Jay Torbit moved to waive the rules and place the Ordinance on its second reading, title only. Louisa Relyea seconded the motion. With a roll call vote of eight ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

Joe Waggoner moved to waive the rules and place the Ordinance on its second reading, title only. Louisa Relyea seconded the motion. With a roll call vote of eight ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Robert Hunter of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality presented a program explaining "Pay-As-You-Throw". We would need to pass a mandatory garbage ordinance, then people would buy orange bags from us for their regular garbage and would be given blue bags for recyclable things. More will be discussed at the working session.

Henry Bauman of Sharp County Regional Airport Authority told us all about the Airport since it's take-over from Cooper in 1981. They would like us to join in an interlocal agreement with the Cities of Ash Flat, Hardy, and Highland and Sharp County. We would then share in the expense (one-fifth) of the Airport. At this time, they are seeking a grant for updating the runway to handle larger aircraft.
