

**MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL EMERGENCY MEETING**  
**May 27, 1999**

This special meeting was called to order at 2:00 PM Thursday, May 27, 1999 by Mayor Marjorie Rogers. The meeting was held at the City Hall.

Mayor Rogers explained the situation of the Suburban Improvement District's giving up law enforcement as of December 31, 1999. She also explained this meeting was necessary so an ordinance could be passed so we can get an ORI number from the FBI in order to apply for any available police department grants.

Clerk/Treasurer Maynard read **An Ordinance to establish a Police Department for the City of Cherokee Village, Arkansas, and to prescribe the duties for said members of the Police Department.** Mayor Rogers declared the Ordinance open for discussion. Mrs. Relyea moved to waive the rules and place the Ordinance on its second reading, title only. Mr. Betz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote of seven ayes, 0 nays, motion carried.
