OLD BUSINESS:

Obtaining a city flag was discussed – what logo – how much to spend. Mr. Radebaugh will get with Russ Stokes of Village Pride and get at least two other quotes.

Passage of ordinances by emergency clause was discussed. In 1999 we passed thirteen ordinances, six by emergency. So far in 2000, five ordinances have been passed, three by emergency clause. Most are due to our becoming a new city and we needed the ordinances to be able to start doing a task. It was agreed that three readings give the public a chance to input their opinions. It was suggested to put a notice in the paper regarding the agenda if ordinances are being considered. Much discussion. Any complaint regarding the bills of assurance, the person needs to come in and sign a complaint. If there are specific problems, we do have procedures.

Mr. Radebaugh asked Mrs. Maynard to read the ordinance presented by Sharp County Regional Airport Authority, **A zoning Ordinance providing for the protection of the airspace surrounding the Sharp County Regional Airport, establishing penalties for the violation thereof and for other purposes.** Mr. Radebaugh asked for discussion. A motion was made by Mr. Dennis to approve the second reading. Marty Betz seconded the motion. With a roll call vote of five ayes, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

It was announced we have received the COPS Grant money for the first quarter. It will be requested monthly now.

Someone from the audience brought up concerns regarding Entergy's spraying of herbicide under power lines. After the rain, did it go into the lakes? The City is obligated to find out. Mr. Betz volunteered to call Entergy and see what they say.
