

CITY OF CHEROKEE VILLAGE, ARKANSAS
Special Meeting, City Council Minutes
April 4, 2001

This special meeting was called to order at 2:00 PM Wednesday, April 4, 2001 by Mayor Marjorie Rogers. The meeting was held at City Hall.

ROLL CALL:

Mayor Rogers announced the purpose of this special meeting was to clarify the Council's position of the Cherokee Village Promotion Committee.

Motion was made by Tom Paul and seconded by Mrs. Relyea for continuance of the Cherokee Village Promotion Committee. The chairman will open an account at Union Planter's Bank using his social security number until his application for a Tax-Free Federal I.D. numbers is obtained. The account will be opened as Cherokee Village Promotion Committee. Money will be transferred to this account from the city account that was set up for this purpose. The City will amend the City Budget accordingly. City of Cherokee Village stationery will be supplied only for requested information from the promotional ads. All promotional expense invoices shall be sent in care of Oral Henderson.

Much discussion. Packets would be mailed by the Spring River Chamber of Commerce, with our letterhead used as a "thank you" letter. After much more discussion the motion was amended as follows:

Motion was made by Tom Paul and seconded by Mrs. Relyea for continuance of the Cherokee Village Promotion Committee as a separate entity, apart from the City of Cherokee Village. The chairman would open an account at Union Planter's Bank using his social security number until his application for a Tax-Free Federal I.D. numbers could be obtained. The account would be opened as Cherokee Village Promotion Committee. Money would be transferred to this account from the city account that was set up for this purpose. The City will amend the City Budget accordingly. City of Cherokee Village stationery will be supplied only for requested information from the promotional ads. All promotional expense invoices and future donations to the committee will be sent to the Cherokee Village Promotion Committee. This motion rescinds Resolution 2001-03, passed March 19, 2001, and all previous motions regarding this committee. Mrs. Maynard called the roll: Mr. Bartlett, yes; Mr. Betz, yes; Mr. Dark, yes; Scott Paul, yes; Tom Paul, yes; Mrs. Relyea, yes; Mr. Stroup, yes; Mr. Torbit, yes. Motion passed.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Motion was made by Mr. Dark and seconded by Mr. Stroup to allow the Planning and Zoning Department to appoint a representative to attend the Municipal League Convention in June as Mr. Bartlett will be unable to attend and Mr. & Mrs. Hrezo may not be able to attend. Mrs. Maynard called the roll: Mr. Bartlett, yes; Mr. Betz, yes; Mr. Dark, yes; Scott Paul, yes; Tom Paul, yes; Mrs. Relyea, yes; Mr. Stroup, yes; Mr. Torbit, yes. Motion passed.

Mayor Rogers asked that all who are able attend the Sharp County Quorum Court Monday, April 9 in support of E-9-1-1.

Motioned to adjourn was made by Chuck Bartlett and seconded by Jack Stroup. With a voice vote of eight ayes, 0 nays, motion carried unanimously.
