City Council Minutes

March 16, 2006

The monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM Thursday, March 16, 2006 by Mayor Ray Maynard. The meeting was held at City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited; he called for the roll and declared a quorum.

AGENDA: Motion to adopt the agenda was made by Mr. Martin and seconded by Mrs. Chelsvig. Discussion. With a voice vote of seven ayes, motion carried.

With a vote of seven ayes, motion carried. Mayor Maynard asked Mrs. Romans to read **An Ordinance to amend Ordinance 99-2 to allow the parking of school buses within the city limits of Cherokee Village, Arkansas**, title only. Motion to accept the third reading of the ordinance was made by Mr. Martin and seconded by Mr. Stokes. Discussion. With a vote of seven ayes, motion carried. Mayor Maynard asked Mrs. Romans to read **An Ordinance to amend Ordinance 2003-12 to regulate installation and repair of sewage disposal systems in the City Cherokee Village, Fulton and Sharp Counties, Arkansas**, title only. Motion to accept the third reading of the ordinance was made by Mr. Martin and seconded by Mr. Stokes. Discussion. Mrs. Romans called the roll: Kent Viers, yes; June Chelsvig, yes; Peter Martin, yes; Scott Paul, yes; Angela Petersen, yes; Russ Stokes, yes; and Petr Oberding, yes. With a vote of seven ayes, motion carried. Ordinance will be **2006-04**.
- c. Revised 2006 Budget: Mr. Stokes made a motion to accept the revised 2006 budget and Mr. Paul seconded. Discussion – Mr. Martin suggested that in the future the lines be numbered for easier reference. Mr. Martin asked if money was being pulled from savings (the \$80K) to balance the street budget. Mayor Maynard explained the funding process.

Mr. Martin stated he would like to have a meeting scheduled with the City of Highland to see if they would help finish their end of Pontiac Dr and Mr. Paul seconded. Discussion. With a voice vote of seven ayes motion carried. Mayor Maynard will schedule a meeting with Highland.
