

CITY OF CHEROKEE VILLAGE, ARKANSAS
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
CITY COUNCIL REPORT
MAY 14, 2008

The special meeting was called to order by the Honorable Mayor Lloyd Hefley at approximately 6:35 PM in the Senior Center on Wednesday, May 14, 2008.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Clerk Endrihs called roll. Present were Newman, Martin, Petersen, Stokes and Thone. Absent were Oberding, Paul and Viers. City Attorney Jon Abele was also present.

Topic of this meeting was to vote on a Temporary Special Use Permit to be issued to the Cherokee Village Lions Club for their sponsoring of Bluff City Shows Carnival to be held May 15-17, 2008 in Choctaw Center. The delay in getting a permit was due to a misunderstanding between the Lions Club and City Hall.

Stokes moved that we approve the permit, seconded by Thone. Discussion followed with comments from the Lions Club members regarding their Lions Program in general. The Council questioned the insurance coverage, hours of the carnival, etc. The Council asked that the noise be cut back around 10:00 PM even if the carnival remained open. This can be done. In answer to a question regarding questionable individuals, Doug Driesel replied that he has known this company for years and that the man in charge, Delmar Giles, always stays on top of people or problems out of the ordinary.

Roll call vote was then taken: YES: Newman, Martin, Petersen, Stokes and Thone. Motion passed.

Stokes moved that we adjourn; unanimously agreed.
