

ORDINANCE 2001-01

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A STREET DEPARTMENT FOR
THE CITY OF CHEROKEE VILLAGE, ARKANSAS, AND TO PRESCRIBE
THE DUTIES FOR SAID MEMBERS OF THE STREET DEPARTMENT.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEROKEE VILLAGE,
ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the maintenance, repair and up-keep of the streets of the City of Cherokee Village, Arkansas, shall be vested in and delegated to the hereinafter established Street Department. The Street Department is hereby established, as the street maintenance agency for the purpose of assisting and/or maintaining, repairing and upgrading the streets of the City of Cherokee Village, Arkansas.

SECTION 2. That the Street Department shall consist of one person known and designated as the Street Superintendent, and such other personnel as the City Council may provide, who shall meet the requirements and rules as may be prescribed by the City Council from time to time. Said Superintendent shall be appointed. Said personnel shall be appointed by the Superintendent subject to the approval of the City Council. The Superintendent shall be responsible for the personnel as may be designated by the City Council.

SECTION 3.

- A. That the membership of the Street Department shall be determined by the City Council, from time to time, increasing or decreasing the membership as occasion demands and their salaries shall be fixed and determined by the City Council subject to the increase or decrease as the occasion demands.
- B. The City of Cherokee Village is an "at will" employer.

SECTION 4. The Street Department and its membership shall be the maintenance agency charged with the responsibility of assisting and/or maintaining, repairing and upgrading the streets within the City of Cherokee Village, Arkansas. The Superintendent shall attend all City Council meetings and make his monthly report to the City Council concerning the operation and equipment of the department, and such other matters as shall be determined necessary by ordinance of the City Council. Other duties shall be such as are fixed by the laws of the State and ordinances of the City.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is not intended to interfere with Cherokee Village Suburban Improvement District's chartered purpose, rights or responsibilities.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
