

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-02

WHEREAS, a Farmer's Market for the sale of fresh homegrown fruits and vegetables, farm produce and firewood, will be established within the City of Cherokee Village, Sharp County.

WHEREAS, a Farmer's Market will be located at City Hall parking lot, being held every Saturday from the hours of seven (7) a.m. to one (1) p.m. beginning Saturday, May 18, 2002. There shall be a minimum of four (4) spaces available each Saturday. Each space shall consist of two (2) parking spaces and shall be located at the lower curved area of the parking lot. Signs will be located in the Farmer's Market area prohibiting general parking during the hours set aside for sellers.

WHEREAS, a no-fee permit shall be issued by the Planning & Zoning Commission during regular business hours. All permits shall be issued on a first come, first served basis, during the week before each sale, with a separate permit being required for each market day.

WHEREAS, the City of Cherokee Village will not be responsible for injuries or theft.

WHEREAS, all tables or sun shades put up must be of a temporary nature and must be removed at the end of each day.

WHEREAS, each vendor will be responsible for keeping the area clean and will remove any and all trash at the end of each day.

WHEREAS, there will be no selling of vehicles, animals, flowers/plants, flea market items, etc. All goods or merchandise in question shall be subject to the approval of Planning & Zoning, and all determinations by Planning & Zoning shall be final.

WHEREAS, any vendor not complying with this Resolution, causing a public disturbance or in any way causing a nuisance, shall be required to leave immediately and may not be eligible for a permit until so determined by Planning & Zoning.

WHEREAS, from time to time, there may be extended sale times, directed by the Planning & Zoning Commission; i.e., the sale of firewood in the fall and winter, the Shriner's sale of onions, and others, the time of which shall be in the sole discretion of Planning & Zoning.

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the City Council, with concurrence of the Mayor:

1. To recognize the efforts of the Planning & Zoning Commission.


