ORDINANCE NO. 2005-05

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 99-4 PROVIDING FOR LICENSING AND ANIMAL CONTROL WITHIN THE CITY OF CHEROKEE VILLAGE, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Cherokee Village City Council that the Cherokee Village Ordinance providing for licensing and animal control within the City of Cherokee Village, Arkansas, establishing penalties for the violation thereof and for other purposes adopted by Ordinance 99-4 on March 15, 1999, be amended as follows:

SECTION 1:

Section 10: Impoundment

Strike the word "officer" and add the word "authority".

SECTION 10: IMPOUNDMENT

- (a) Any animal at large or otherwise in violation of the provisions of this ordinance may be impounded in an animal shelter in a humane manner for a period of not less than five (5) working days; and, if within such time, an animal so impounded has not been reclaimed by its owner or harborer in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, such animal shall become the absolute property of the animal control authority which may convey ownership of such animal to any responsible person on such conditions as the animal control authority may prescribe, or the animal control authority may humanely destroy such animal. No animal shall be maintained at City expense in excess of five (5) days unless specifically authorized by the Animal Control Officer. Authority.
- (b) The animal control officer <u>authority</u> shall make a reasonable effort to notify the owner of any animal impounded in an animal shelter that the animal has been impounded, of the manner by which the animal may be reclaimed, and that the animal may be destroyed or become the property of the animal control authority as provided herein.


