ORDINANCE 99-13

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CHEROKEE VILLAGE WEAPONS USE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE 99-12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Cherokee Village City Council that the weapons use rules and regulations adopted by Ordinance 99-12 on September 20, 1999, be amended as follows:

SECTION I. Prohibitions on Discharges, etc.:

An addition to read as follows:

All bow instruments including compound bow, crossbow, recurved bow and long bow. All pellet guns including "B-B" guns, air rifles or pistols and any other such weapon that is gas, air or spring operated.

SECTION II. Exceptions.:

An addition to read as follows:

This ordinance does not restrict the discharge of pellet guns or bow instruments on private property (such as target practice on owner's properties, etc.), providing projectiles do not travel to adjacent or other property.

SECTION III. Severability clause: If any part of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining parts of this ordinance.

SECTION IV. Emergency: Because of the large number of residents in the Cherokee Village City Limits and because said weapons represent an immediate potential danger to the residents of their health, safety, and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
