2019 ARKANSAS STREETS GRANT

CHEROKEE VILLAGE

Cherokee Village has been awarded an Arkansas City Streets Improvement Grant in 2018. It is for \$250,000. and will be used for a Hot Mix Asphalt overlay. The project scope will include paving from Highway 175, Iroquois Drive, through Iroquois Circle, Sequoyah Ridge Road to Hiawatha Drive, turning right to Pontiac Drive and turning left on Pontiac to Highway 62 + 167.

The grant project was put up for contractor bids on January 16, 2019. An Arkansas State Resident Highway Project Engineer will be assigned shortly. Atlas Asphalt was awarded the contract.

The project total cost may reach \$304,470.28. with the possible \$54,470.28. overage balance being paid for by the City of Cherokee Village. CVSD is requesting that a portion of this overage in the amount of \$25,000.00 will be approved and paid by the Cherokee Village City Council. The CV Council has already approved the acceptance of this project. CVSD will pay the balance using portions of their 2019 road repair materials budget. The Arkansas Department of Transportation will not proceed with this project until this additional amount of \$54,470.28 is paid by a city check.

Our project will be timed with the City of Highland's Arkansas Streets Grant 2019 Project. They are having a Hot Mix Asphalt overlay on the Ridgecrest and Valley Heart areas.

The paving project start date is unknown at this time.
