RESOLUTION SUPPORTING U.S. ARMED FORCES

Whereas, we believe that democratic governments are instituted for the benefit of mankind and that no government can exist in peace, except where laws are framed and held inviolate so as to secure each individual the free exercise of conscience, the right and control of property, and the protection of life and,

Whereas, no free society can stand without lofty patriotism, virtue in its people, a willingness to sacrifice for its common defense, and a liberty that must be earned by eternal vigilance.
