## AMENDMENT NO. 2014- 04

# AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHEROKEE VILLAGE ZONING CODE ORDINANCE 99-2 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Cherokee Village City Council that the Cherokee Village Zoning Code adopted by Ordinance 99-2 on February 15, 1999, be amended as follows:

#### **SECTION 1. TITLE**

This code shall be known, cited and referred to as: The Cherokee Village addition to DISTRICT R-1 STANDARD SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT.

### SECTION 2. DISTRICT R-1 STANDARD SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

A. PERMITTED USES. The following shall be included as: In District R-1, **no** metal or prefabricated carports are allowed; carports must be stick built with trusses only and the roof color must match the house roof color. In District R-1 no building, structure, land or premises shall be used, and no building or structure shall be hereafter erected, constructed, reconstructed moved or altered, except for one or more of the following uses:

- 1. Dwellings, one family, excluding manufactured homes as defined by the International Building Code 2000 and Federal Standards under Arkansas Code § 20-25-102.
- 2. Parks and playgrounds, including recreation or service buildings and swimming pools, which are owned or operated by a governmental agency.
- 3. Public schools.
- 4. Golf courses and clubhouses appurtenant thereto wherein food and alcoholic beverages may be served, (except miniature golf courses, commercial driving ranges and other similar activities operated as a business)
- 5. Nurseries, and truck gardens limited to the propagation and cultivation of plants; provided no retail or wholesale business shall be conducted upon the premises.
- 6. Churches and synagogues.

#### **SECTION 3.** BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

The Zoning Codes may be amended and/or changed as necessary by the Planning Commission and presented to the City Council for approval.
