**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF
THE CITY OF CHEROKEE VILLAGE**

TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, *The City of Cherokee Village* understands Federal-aid Recreational Trails Program Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match/in kind labor to develop or improve Tohi Trail Expansion, and

WHEREAS, *The City of Cherokee Village* understands that Federal-aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement, and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the applicant for the life of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF CHEROKEE VILLAGE'S CITY COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION I: *The City of Cherokee Village* will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility, including maintenance of this project.

SECTION II: *Mayor Russell Stokes* is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the above stated project.

SECTION III: *The City of Cherokee Village's City Council* pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas Department of Transportation to initiate action to implement this project.
