A RESOLUTION TO SET COUNCIL MEETINGS DATES AND TIMES

WHEREAS, subject to 14-43-501. Organization of city council. Statues (a)(1). The aldermen elected for each city or town shall annually, at the first council meeting in January, assemble and organize the city council and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cherokee Village is made up of people of all ages, and it is the desire of the City Council that everyone who wants to attend the City Council meetings would have the opportunity and,

WHEREAS, some of the people who live in Cherokee Village are still working, and it is hard for them to get off from work to attend Council meetings,

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby RESOLVED by the City Council with concurrence of the Mayor, that

1. During 2008 there will be one regular City Council meeting each month. If there is a second meeting necessary, it will be a called special meeting. Such a special Council meeting will be announced and notice given to all Councilmen at least two hours prior.
2. The monthly meeting of the City Council will be the third Thursday of each month. The agenda will be set by noon on the Friday prior to the meeting, and alderman packets will be ready by close of business on the same Friday.
3. The time of the monthly meeting of the City Council will be 7:00 P. M.
