

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEROKEE VILLAGE, SHARP & FULTON COUNTIES, STATE OF ARKANSAS, SUPPORTING THE DISPLAY OF THE NATIONAL MOTTO "IN GOD WE TRUST" IN A PROMINENT LOCATION IN THE CHEROKEE VILLAGE CITY HALL

WHEREAS, "In God we Trust" became the United States national motto on July 30, 1956, shortly after our nation led the world through the trauma of World War; and

WHEREAS, the words have been used on U. S. currency since 1864; and

WHEREAS, the same inspiring slogan is engraved above the entrance to the Senate Chamber as well as above the Speaker's dais in the House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, in both war and peace, these words have been a profound source of strength and guidance to many generations of Americans; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cherokee Village desires to display this patriotic motto in the Cherokee Village City Hall as a way to solemnize public occasions and express confidence in our society;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of the City of Cherokee Village does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1: That the City Council of the City of Cherokee Village, Arkansas, does hereby determine that the historic and patriotic words of our national motto, "In God We Trust" shall be permanently and prominently displayed in Cherokee Village City Hall.

SECTION 2: The Clerk/Treasurer shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution.
