RESOLUTION # 1998-

Consent to the Incorporation of the Town of Highland, Arkansas. The recently formed town of Cherokee Village lying in Sharp and Fulton Counties acting by and through its elected city council comprised of Alderman and Mayor does on this $2/2^{t}$ day of Sat. 19 98 acknowledge and consent as follows:

(1) WHEREAS; it is acknowledged that the corporate limits of the existing municipality of the town of Cherokee Village are located within five (5) miles and in fact in some portions and parts adjoining the corporate limits of the proposed town of Highland, Sharp County, Arkansas.

(2) WHEREAS; that the citizens and residents of the proposed City of Highland, Sharp County, Arkansas have the right to form a town or city so as to have input in the governmental actions which touches and concerns their daily life and business;

(3) WHEREAS; Ark. Code. Ann., 14-38-101 (b) (1) requires that

"the (County) Court shall not approve the incorporation of any municipality if any portion of the territory proposed to be embraced in the incorporated town shall lie within five (5) miles from the corporate limits of existing municipal corporation unless the governing body of the municipal corporation has, by written resolution, affirmatively consented to the incorporation." NOW WHEREFORE, by unanimous vote of the City Council the town of Cherokee Village does, by this resolution, affirmatively consent to the incorporation of the town of Highland located in the County of Sharp, State of Arkansas.
